A verification record for legal, financial, accessibility, privacy, and official voting information.

Purpose and operating standard

Complete before adapting any Academy resource to a specific election or jurisdiction.

Use verified information, assign a named owner, protect personal data, and confirm jurisdiction-specific legal or election requirements with the authorized campaign official or election authority.

Source hierarchy

- Use the current election authority and legislation first.
- Record the version/date checked.
- Route ambiguous questions to the authorized campaign official, treasurer, compliance professional, or legal counsel.
- Do not treat Academy examples as jurisdiction-specific legal advice.
