Core doorstep conversation

Stage	Completed wording / action
Opening	Hi, I'm Priya, a local volunteer with Jordan Lee's campaign. We're speaking with neighbours about the October council election. Is Alex available?
Reason	Jordan is focused on safer crossings, reliable recreation programs, and practical property-tax accountability.
Question	What issue would you most like the next council to address?
Listen and connect	That concern about speeding on Cedar Avenue has come up often. Jordan supports a traffic-calming review with published timelines and resident input.
Support ID	Based on what you've heard, are you leaning toward Jordan, considering Jordan, undecided, or supporting someone else?
Close	Thank you. May we send election reminders by email or text? The advance poll is October 10-12.

Completed branches

Situation	Response
Busy voter	Absolutely - I'll be brief. Jordan's priorities are safer streets and accountable local services. May I leave this card and ask whether you are currently decided?
Undecided	That makes sense. Which local issue will matter most in your decision? I can make sure the campaign sends relevant information rather than general material.
No support	Thank you for letting me know. I appreciate your time and will update our list so we do not keep asking.
Hostile / unsafe	End politely: "Understood. Have a good evening." Leave immediately and record only the operational note required.

Field	Entry
Result	Possible support
Issue	Traffic safety / speeding
Contact permission	Email consent provided
Follow-up	Send traffic-safety priority page within 24 hours
Notes	Prefers concise email; no phone calls
